RESOLUTION NO. 2015-114

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 5285 ENTITLED: *CHILDREN'S EMERGENCY RELIEF AND PROTECTION ACT* AND ITS SENATE COUNTERPART BILL

"Presented for consideration of the Body is Committee Report No. 7-2015 of the Committee on Social Welfare, Housing, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, chaired by the Honorable June S. Mondejar, relative to the request for a resolution of support to House Bill No. 5285 entitled: *Children's Emergency Relief and Protection Act*;

WHEREAS, one of the salient features of this House Bill is the Comprehensive Emergency Program for children which shall be implemented immediately after the declaration of a national or local state of calamity to protect the children and support their immediate recovery. The Comprehensive Emergency Program for children shall be gender-sensitive and has the following components: establishment of shelter for displaced children; assurance for immediate delivery of basic necessities and services; stronger measures to ensure the safety and security of affected children; timely delivery of health, medical, and nutrition services; plan of action for prompt resumption of educational services for children; establishment of emergency centers and promotion of children's right. Other features of the House Bill No. 5285 are as follows: Evacuation Centers; Unaccompanied or Separated Children; Data Gathering and Reporting; Heightened Surveillance Against Child Trafficking, Child Labor, Child Prostitution, and Violence on Children; System of Restoring Legal Documents; and Training of First Responders;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, it is deemed proper that this August Body support House Bill No. 5285 and its Senate counterpart bill;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Honorable June S. Mondejar, Floor Leader and Chairperson, Committee on Social Welfare, Housing, Senior Citizens and Persons with Disability, which was duly seconded;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby Resolved, to support House Bill No. 5285 entitled: *Children's Emergency Relief and Protection Act* and its Senate counterpart bill;




